Cultural & Heritage of Malacca – with meal (GMAL01WM)

Duration: approx. 6-7 hours (including travelling time)

Price: SGD\$87 per Adult, SGD\$62 per Child

PARTICIPANTS REQUIRED: MIN 30 PAX & MAX 200 PAX

- **Malacca Malay House** – it exhibits the typical lifestyle of a rich Malaysian family in the early 20th century and showcase a traditional Malay house setup.
- **Trishaw Ride (15 mins)** - the traditional trishaw will take you through streets and corners of Melaka's historic city centre.
- **Baba Nyonya Heritage Museum** – show casing the lifestyle of an affluent Baba Nyonya family. The Babas and Nyonyas are the offspring of the Chinese who came from China and intermarried the local ladies. Babas and Nyonyas do not speak Chinese but only English and Malay patios.
- **Lunch at a popular Nyonya Restaurant** - Nyonya cuisine is the cuisine of the Baba Nyonya community. The food is mix of Chinese and Malay cuisine.
- **Melaka Straits Mosque** (outside visit) – the beautiful mosque was built so that when the water tide is at just the right height, the Mosque looks like it is floating on the ocean.
- **Jonker Street** – it was once renowned for its antique shops, however over the years it has turned to clothing and crafts outlets as well as restaurants.

Safari Wonderland - with meal (GMAL02WM)

Duration: approx. 6-7 hours (include travelling time)

- **Lunch** at a local Chinese restaurant.
- **A Famosa Resort Animal World Safari** – here in the Animal World Safari, you will encounter many animals such as tigers, zebras, elephants, lions, giraffes, camel and other animals that roam freely in the Safari. Go near the rabbits and other animals as you feed and pet them in the Walk-Through Area. Experience the world of chickens at the Chicken Farm. Go on the raft to Monkey Island and see the many species of monkeys that are reared here.

- **Stadthuys** (outside visit) – a piece of artistry built circa 1650, with traces of Dutch masonry and carpentry. Find it in the walls, the doors and windows, the iron hinges and floral-engraved wooden ceiling.
- **Cheng Ho Cultural Museum** – It was built in the honor of a Chinese Ming Dynasty admiral called Cheng Ho or Zheng He. Cheng Ho was a famous Chinese explorer, who went to the Middle East, Africa and South East Asia between 1405 and 1433. In one of these voyages he came to Melaka, and he is credited with the honor of discovering the Melaka Port for the Chinese. The museum is filled with artifacts related to the great explorer. There are about 2,000 items of historical importance related to Cheng Ho and the Ming Dynasty on display at the museum, including crockery, coins, the Cheng Ho Well, clothing and a replica of Cheng Ho's ship.
- **Jonker Street** – it was once renowned for its antique shops, however over the years it has turned to clothing and crafts outlets as well as restaurants.
- Enjoy **Nyonya Tea Break** at Casa Del Rio Hotel.
